Bill: HB1921 Bill Subtitle: TO AMEND THE LAW CREATING A SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIANS.

Basic Change :

Sponsor: Rep. Vaught

HB1921 amends § 27-24-1306 to change "emergency medical technicians" to "emergency medical services professionals" for special license plate purposes. HB1921 changes the fund where special license plates are deposited from EMT Association Benevolence and Scholarship Fund to Emergency Medical Services Foundation, Inc.

Revenue Impact :

None.

Taxpayer Impact :

Vehicle owners may register their vehicles with a special plate supporting the Emergency Medical Services Foundation, Inc.

Resources Required :

Programing will be necessary to change fund names.

Time Required :

Implementation date November 13, 2017 is requested.

Procedural Changes :

Program the motor vehicle system for issuance of the new plate. Revise Motor Vehicle Procedures Manual and distribute revisions to Revenue Offices.

Other Comments :

None.

Legal Analysis :

HB1921 would amend § 27-24-1306 to create a special license plate for emergency medical service professionals. The fee remitted for the license shall be deposited into the State Central Services Fund for the benefit of the Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and Administration and the specified Emergency Service Professional charity.
