Legislative Impact Statement

Bill: HB2069 Bill Subtitle: CONCERNING THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE ACCESS TO PARKING FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES ACT; AND TO CREATE A MEANS FOR REPORTING THE MISUSE OF PARKING PRIVILEGES.

Basic Change :

Sponsor: Rep. Hammer

HB2069 allows the Office of Motor Vehicle to develop and implement procedures for reporting misuse of persons with disabilities plates, placards, and parking in spaces exclusively for person with disabilities. The Office of Motor Vehicle shall promulgate rules for implementation of the reporting procedures.

Revenue Impact :

Unknown cost to develop and implement a telephone hotline or web portal to report parking violations.

Taxpayer Impact :

Taxpayers would have a number to call and report misuse of disability plates, placards, and persons parking in spaces exclusively for those disabled.

Resources Required :

Additional programing will be necessary for reports.

Time Required :

Implementation date of November 13, 2017 is requested.

Procedural Changes :

Revise Motor Vehicle Procedures Manual and distribute revisions to 134 Revenue Offices. Staff training on reporting and maintaining call volume.

Other Comments :

None.

Legal Analysis :

This bill concerns the enforcement of the Access to Parking for Persons with Disabilities Act and creates a means for reporting the misuse of parking privileges. The Office of Motor Vehicle (OMV) may develop and implement a means by which a person may report by telephone hotline, submitting a form online, or by mail allegations of misuse of a special license plate, special certificate, or parking space designated for parking by persons with disabilities. OMV shall promulgate rules for the proper implementation of this section.
