13	school districts, and may include programs and services such as staff
14	development, curriculum development, instructional materials, education for
15	children with disabilities, adult education programs, alternative educational
16	programs, and community-based education programs; and
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18	WHEREAS, the State of Arkansas is statutorily required to provide funds
19	to support the basic structure of education service cooperatives, including
20	salaries and fringe benefits, related costs, funds to support staff and
21	curriculum development activities, and funds to cover certain travel expenses
22	of personnel employed by education service cooperatives to serve the part-
23	time needs of public school districts; and
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25	WHEREAS, education service cooperatives are public agencies, and
26	therefore are eligible to receive and expend public and private funds; and
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28	WHEREAS, education service cooperatives are evaluated at least one (1)
29	time within each five-year period on a schedule established by the
30	Commissioner of Elementary and Secondary Education, with such evaluations
31	including investigations of user satisfaction, service adequacy, the extent
32	of local financial support, staff qualifications, and performance and
33	administration effectiveness; and
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35	WHEREAS, the House Committee on Education should study education
36	service cooperatives to determine if there are changes necessary to address
