Industry Training Program Quarterly Report Pursuant to Act 218 of 2022

Pursuant to Act 218 of 2022, the Arkansas Economic Development Commission (AEDC) is submitting a quarterly report regarding activity for the Industry Training Program (ITP). The purpose of the program is to provide funds to a company that will undertake an economic development project to support the training needs for new and existing employees. AEDC may utilize ITP funds for personal services, operating expenses, grants and aid, capital acquisition, and other appropriate purposes to provide industry-specific training opportunities.

During the 4th quarter of State Fiscal Year 2023, AEDC entered into no new agreements with companies to receive ITP funds and disbursed \$63,000 in previously awarded funds. Information regarding activity for the program is in the attached document.
