The Arkansas Division of Workforce Services (ADWS) respectfully requests Arkansas Legislative Council (ALC) approval of an appropriation authorized under Section 36 of Act 2 of 2020, in the amount of $\$ 25,000,000$.

On August 25, 2020, ADWS was approved for the FEMA Lost Wages supplemental payment Assistance (LWA). To date, three weeks of payments have been distributed through LWA, with the CARES Act Steering Committee having approved $\$ 8$ million to satisfy the state match requirement.

In light of the continued needs of Arkansans still facing unemployment as a result of COVID-19 and the availability of further FEMA assistance, ADWS now respectfully requests to apply for an additional three weeks of assistance through LWA as allowed by FEMA and President Trump's August executive order. The purpose of the $\$ 25,000,000$ appropriation request is to ensure adequate appropriation to meet matching requirements as specified by FEMA upon application for additional assistance.

If approved, the requested $\$ 25$ million appropriation will allow ADWS to utilize the previously approved $\$ 8$ million in CARES Act funding as well as any additional funds to the meet the state match required by FEMA for the LWA program for the proposed additional three weeks. At this time, ADWS estimates the need for additional funds to meet the state match to be approximately $\$ 10$ million to $\$ 15$ million. Subject to legislative approval, ADWS will submit a request to the CARES Act Steering Committee for the requisite funds identified by FEMA.
