Dear Senator Bledsoe and Representative Wardlaw:

According to Ark. Code Ann. §19-11-264, all contracts with a member of the General Assembly, his or her spouse, or with any business in which such person or his or her spouse is an officer, a director, or a stockholder owning more than ten percent (10%) of the stock in the business must be presented to the Arkansas Legislative Council (ALC) before the execution date of the contract.

The Office of State Procurement (OSP) of the Department of Transformation and Shared Services (TSS) conducted TSS OSP solicitation SP-21-0015 for state vehicle contract pricing. It resulted in the anticipated award of state contracts for two types of vehicles to JSJ Ford, Inc. (JSJ Ford) of Morrilton because its bid was the lowest submitted for those two types of vehicles. The first item was item 16 of the solicitation which was for extended cab, ¾ ton pickup trucks. Of the five bidders for that item, JSJ Ford's bid of \$25,646 was the lowest. The second item awarded them was item 47 of the solicitation which was for 8-passenger SUVs. Of three bids for that item, JSJ Ford submitted the lowest bid of \$36,998.

The contract to be awarded is 4600047790. It is being presented to ALC as required by Ark. Code Ann. §19-11-264 because State Representative Stephen Magie owns a 33% share of JSJ Ford. Based on the fact that the contract is being awarded on the basis of the lowest price, TSS OSP asks for ALC's favorable review of the contract.

OUTLINE AGREEMENT AWARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. GENERAL: All terms and conditions stated in the invitation for bid govern this contract.
- 2. PRICES: Prices are firm and not subject to escalation, unless otherwise specified in the invitation for bid.
- 3. DISCOUNTS: All cash discounts offered will be taken if earned.
- 4. TAXES: Most state agencies must pay state sales tax. Before billing, the contractor should contact the ordering agency to find out if that agency must pay sales tax. Itemize state sales tax when applicable on invoices.
- 5. BRAND NAME REFERENCES: The contractor guarantees that the commodity delivered is the same as specified in the bid.
- 6. GUARANTY: All items delivered are to be newly manufactured, in first- class condition, latest model and design, including, where applicable, containers suitable for shipment and storage unless otherwise indicated in the bid invitation. If the contractor has provided services and there are no longer funds legally available to pay for the

services, the contractor may file a claim.
