RE: State Park Property Acquisition

Dear Ms. Garrity:

The Arkansas Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism - State Parks Division (ASP) seeks acquisition by donation of select properties to protect and preserve natural, cultural, and historic resources and provide additional recreational and educational opportunities for park visitors. The following is a brief description of the proposed acquisition. Additional details are provided in attached documents. Grant funds will be utilized for development of this priority property.

 Delta Heritage Trail State Park: ASP proposes acquisition through donation of lots and partial lots all within Block 19 of Arkansas City, along with the donation of a platted alleyway to be abandoned all totaling approximately 1.10 acres of land adjacent to the Delta Heritage Trail State Park's Arkansas City Trailhead.

In accordance with Ark. Code Ann. § 22-4-106, I am respectfully requesting your favorable advice to complete this property acquisition. Initial approval of this acquisition was granted by the State Parks, Recreation, and Travel Commission on April 22, 2021. Favorable advice from Governor Hutchinson was received on May 24, 2021 and favorable advice from the Department of Finance and Administration was received on May 26, 2021 (enclosed). ## <u>Delta Heritage Trail Land Donation at Arkansas City – Purpose & Summary</u>

## **Property Description:**

The subject property is located in part of the SE ¼ of the SW ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 33, Township 12 South, Range 1 West. More particularly, it is located within the city limits of Arkansas City and described as a part of Lot 5, all of Lots 6-9, a part of Lot 10, all of Lots 25 and 26, and part of the platted alleyway all within Block 19, Original Town of Arkansas City, Desha County.

Estimated acreage is approximately 1.10 acres, subject to a revised land survey.

## **Purpose:**

As part of the requirements of the Walton Family Foundation Grant to the Arkansas Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism (ADPHT) for completion of the Delta Heritage Trail (DHT), a recognition piece for the life and accomplishments of John H. Johnson (J.H.J.) is to be included as a component of the trail development.

Through discussion with the Walton Family Foundation and with the Friends of J.H.J. group, ADPHT Planning and Development (P&D) staff have determined that our existing land holdings and opportunities in Arkansas City would not be sufficient to support the proposed recognition piece and its support facilities. P&D also does not recommend locating a J.H.J component in any other DHT location, due to Arkansas City being the birthplace and boyhood home of John H. Johnson.

As such, ADPHT is recommending that land adjacent to our existing DHT Robert S. Moore, Jr. Arkansas City Trailhead be acquired for the development of the J.H.J component through a donation of land to ADPHT. Both the City of Arkansas City and Mr. and Mrs. Robert Moore are agreeable to donation of the properties for development by ADPHT per the attached map.

## **Estimated cost:**

Acquisition is planned as a land donation to ADPHT. Costs for the acquisition would be limited to those for land survey, title search, title commitment, title insurance policy, and all other relevant and normal closing costs.


