UAMS Institute for Digital Health \& Innovation (IDHI) will review applications for the Arkansas Rural Connect grant program administered through the Economic Development Commission office. IDHI will review applications for two main purposes; (1) to determine whether the activities described in the grant application can provide the determined broadband (i.e. 25/3 or 100/100 symmetrical) to towns based on the technical details and network design and (2) to review and approve reimbursable expenses for each project. In addition, UAMS IDHI will engage in principal oversight of implementation of broadband infrastructure construction awards to ISPs and municipalities as designated by the Arkansas Department of Commerce. UAMS IDHI will strategically review guidelines for the ARC broadband implementation projects within each region and awarded ISP network, and report to the State of Arkansas Department of Commerce should projects fall into non-compliance.
