

Average Number of Eligibles per Month (1st Quarter SFY12) by Aid Category, Adults and Children (including ARKids First and CHIP)









# MEDICAID ELIGIBILITY CHANGES JULY – SEPTEMBER 2011

Effective Date	Description of Eligibility Change		
07-25-11	MS 11-14, SAVE Response Denial Notice. Provide instructions on sending denial notices to the applicant/recipient when denial is based on the response from SAVE. SAVE stands for Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlement System.		
08-26-11	MS 11-15, Transferring Cases and Applications. Provide instructions for transferring a pending application and open cases.		
09-02-11	MS 11-16, Medicare Savings Program (MSP) Annual Review Telephone Interview. Provide instructions for completing a telephone interview for the Medicare Savings recipients.		

## MEDICAID POLICY CHANGES JULY - SEPTEMBER 2011

Effective Date	Description of Policy Change
7-1-11	The Transportation Manual has been updated to reflect current driver's license requirements for DDTCS Transportation Providers.
7-1-11	The RSPMI manual has been updated to reflect changes in certification requirements; emergency response plan requirements; standards for quality assurance meetings; and staffing requirements based upon the Arkansas Department of Human Services Division of Behavioral Health Services Certification Manual.
7-1-11	ElderChoices & Alternatives for Adults with Physical Disabilities updated policy regarding services provided on the date of admission to an inpatient facility.
7-1-11	The coinsurance charge per inpatient admission for ARKids First-B participants has changed from 20% to 10% of the hospital's Medicaid per diem.
7-1-11	The Substance Abuse Treatment Services Manual was made available.
8-1-11	Ashworth Scale; Bruininks-Oseretsky Test of Motor Proficiency and Range of Motion tests were added to the Occupational, Physical, Speech Therapy Services manual.
9-15-11	Procedure code S3620 for Newborn Metabolic Screening Panels was moved from the Genetic Testing category to a new category for newborn screening.
