Dear Representative Baker:

As you are aware, the Department of Workforce Services has experienced federal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Program funding cuts.

The expiration of the TANF Supplemental and TANF Emergency Funds, coupled with the exhaustion of the TANF Contingency Fund, has had a far reaching impact upon the TANF Program. Additionally, these cuts have resulted in a rapidly declining TANF Carryforward fund balance.

As we strive to ensure that funding is available to provide the federally-required services to our program participants, we are faced with some rather difficult decisions. One such decision is the need to suspend the use of TANF Program funding for the 2012 – 2013 Fiscal Year for the Community Investment Initiative.

In accordance with Arkansas Act 282 of 2012, I have attached our official certification to this effect.



Pursuant to Arkansas Act 282 of 2012, I, Artee Williams, hereby certify that the Department of Workforce Services in suspending the use of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Program funds for the purposes of the Community Investment Initiative during the 2012 – 2013 Fiscal Year. We further certify that this suspension is in accordance with Arkansas Act 282 of 2012, Section 17:

- a) Funding from the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families block grant is needed to support a critical economic development initiative,
- b) Other funds from the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families block grant are not available beyond those needed for the operation of the TEA, Work Pays and High Wage Education and Training Programs and for an adequate reserve for possible increases in cash assistance during the current fiscal year,
- c) *Spending for the economic development initiative is allowable within the federal rules governing the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Block Grant.

*Note: The Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program allows economic development in the sense that it provides employment opportunities and support for eligible families, not for general job development.
