

**REPORT OF THE
GAME & FISH/STATE POLICE SUBCOMMITTEE
OF THE
ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**

Co-Chairs:

The ALC - Game & Fish/State Police Subcommittee met with representatives from the Arkansas State Police on Wednesday, April 23, 2014, at the State Police Headquarters in Little Rock, Arkansas, and reports the discussion of the following items by the noted speakers:

- A. Colonel Stan Witt, Director, State Police, presented an overview of operations for the Crimes Against Children Division (CACD), reporting overtime issues, a 24-hour response mandate, and rate of staff turnover as areas of concern. To address these concerns, the State Police will be requesting additional CACD Hotline Operator and CACD Investigator positions for fiscal years 2016 and 2017 during the fall budget hearings.
- B. Technology Demonstrations –
 - 1. Kerry Tabor, IT Operations Manager, ASP, demonstrated the Pannin Enforcer In-Car Digital Video Camera System, which allows for vehicle tracking, location recording, and real-time monitoring of traffic stops.
 - 2. Cpl. Doug Cash, Mobile Incident Command Center Coordinator, ASP, demonstrated the Aircraft Down Link avionics technology used by aircraft for law enforcement.
 - 3. James Kingsbury, E Cite Project Manager, ASP, demonstrated the E Citation GPS project, which allows officers to use laptops to input data into eCitation software, scan drivers license information, check for valid insurance, and electronically submit tickets.
