Collections of Gross General Revenues year-to-date of approximately \$5,423 million have increased \$214.2 million, or $4.1 \%$, above the $\$ 5,208.8$ million collected last fiscal year-to-date. Net General Revenue Available for Distribution this month of $\$ 624$ million increased $\$ 53.8$ million, or $9.4 \%$, from the $\$ 570.2$ million available for distribution in April 2014. In accordance with Act 1315 of 1999, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State transferred $\$ 2,251,485.28$ from Corporate Income Tax to the Workforce 2000 Development Fund for a current total of \$22,514,852.80.
