The ALC - Game & Fish/State Police Subcommittee met with officials representing the Department of Arkansas State Police on Wednesday, September 23, 2015, at the State Police Headquarters for an overview of the five Arkansas State Police Divisions, including the Highway Patrol Division, Criminal Investigation Division, Crimes Against Children Division, Administrative Services Division, and Regulatory & Building Operations Division.

Colonel William J. Bryant, Director, State Police, reported that this year marks the 80th year of the Arkansas State Police. Colonel Bryant highlighted past achievements and outlined key issues facing the department, including the continued recruitment of qualified individuals and officer safety development through an increase in mandatory training programs involving weapons and defensive driving.
