MOTION TO DISMISS AND INCORPORATED BRIEF IN SUPPORT

Come now Respondents, Arkansas Department of Corrections – Division of Community Correction (ACC), and Arkansas Department of Corrections – Division of Correction (ADC), by and through undersigned counsel and for their Motion to Dismiss and Incorporated Brief in Support state:

- Claimant, a parolee and sex offender conditionally released from prison to the supervision of the Arkansas Department of Corrections – Division of Community Correction (ACC), alleges that ACC has violated his constitutional rights by enforcing conditions of his supervised release.
- Although ADC was named as a Respondent in this case, Claimant makes no allegations
 against ADC and it should therefore be dismissed as Claimant has failed to state a claim
 for relief against it.
- 3. Claimant has also failed to state facts supporting a claim for relief against ACC and therefore his Claim must be dismissed in its entirety.

- 4. Moreover, the Commission lacks jurisdiction over the claims Claimant purports to bring because they are for civil rights violations that can be brought in a court of general jurisdiction.
- 5. In his Claim Form and attached documents, Claimant alleges ACC violated a variety of his constitutional rights including the Eighth Amendment, the Due Process Clause, and his "Miranda" rights by requiring him as a condition of his parole and sex offender supervision to attend a Halloween Lock-In event at the Monticello Parole and Probation Office to ensure he refrained from participating in Halloween activities as a matter of public safety.
- 4. First, Claimant is incorrect that required participation in a Halloween Lock-In violates any of his constitutional rights. Federal and state courts have held that while an individual is conditionally released from prison under community supervision, the paroling authority has broad discretion to impose conditions of that conditional release. The United States Supreme Court has stated that "[t]he essence of parole is release from prison, before the completion of sentence, on the condition that the prisoner abide by certain rules during the balance of the sentence." *Morrissey v. Brewer*, 408 U.S. 471, 477 (1972). Similarly the Eighth Circuit stated:

Parole is an act of grace and reasonable conditions may be imposed in connection therewith. In *Brown v. Daggett*, 458 F.2d 14 (8th Cir. 1972), we said '(t)he Board of Parole has wide discretion to determine under what conditions an inmate is to be paroled.'

Forester v. California Adult Auth., 510 F.2d 58, 61 (8th Cir. 1975)

5. Because Claimant's constitutional rights were not violated by ACC in imposing the Halloween Lock-in requirement as a condition of his supervised release, his Claim must be dismissed.

- 6. Second, as Claimant stated numerous times, his Claims are based entirely on allegations that ACC employees violated his constitutional rights. These claims could be brought in federal or state court and therefore the Commission lacks jurisdiction over the claims.
- 7. Ark. Code Ann. § 19-10-204(b)(2)(A) specifically states that "[t]he commission shall have jurisdiction only over those claims which are barred by the doctrine of sovereign immunity from being litigated in a court of general jurisdiction." Claims of constitutional violations can be brought as federal civil rights action under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 or in Arkansas state court under the Arkansas Civil Rights Act.
- 8. For the foregoing reasons, Claimant's Claim should be dismissed in its entirety.
 WHEREFORE, Respondents ADC and ACC respectfully request that Claimant's Claim
 be dismissed and for all other relief to which they may be entitled.

RESPONSE IN OPPOSITION TO MOTION FOR DIRECTED VERDICT AND MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

Come now Respondents, Arkansas Department of Corrections – Division of Community Correction (ACC), and Arkansas Department of Corrections – Division of Correction (ADC), by and through undersigned counsel and for their Response to the Motion for Directed Verdict and Motion for Summary Judgment filed by Claimant state:

- 1. Claimant, a parolee and sex offender conditionally released from prison to the supervision of the Arkansas Department of Corrections Division of Community Correction (ACC), has filed three separate Claims based on the same or similar facts. All Claims allege that ACC has violated Claimant's constitutional rights by enforcing various conditions of his supervised release and primarily based on ACC's searches of his property pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 16-93-106, and the Warrantless Search Waiver he signed as a condition of his parole.
- 2. ACC has pending Motions to Dismiss based on failure to state a claim and lack of jurisdiction by the Commission in all three Claims. Although no factual allegations have been made against the ADC, it was named as a Respondent in one of the Claims and a Motion to Dismiss is pending on its behalf as well.

- 3. As stated in the pending Motions to Dismiss, it's clear that the Claims must be dismissed because the Commission doesn't have jurisdiction over Claimant's Claims, and that Claimant has failed to state a claim for relief in any of his Claims.
- 4. In his Motion for Directed Verdict and Summary Judgment, Claimant continues to assert that ACC violated his "civil constitutional rights" including the Eighth Amendment and due process. These assertions support Respondents' position that the Claims must be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction by the Commission.
- 5. Claimant is not entitled to a directed verdict pursuant to Ark. R. Civ. P. 50(a) primarily because there has been no trial in this case. Rule 50(a) motions for directed verdict may only be granted during a trial and at the end of a party's presentation of evidence. Claimant's motion is improper and should be denied.
- 6. Similarly, Claimant's Motion for Summary Judgment is premature at this stage of the case. First, Rule 56(a) only allows a claimant to make a motion for summary judgment "after the expiration of 20 days from the commencement of the action..." Claim No. 230565 was docketed on November 2, 2022, and Claim No. 230636 was docketed on November 8, 2022, both less than 20 days after November 21, 2022 the date on which Claimant signed his Motion and cover letter.
- 7. Second, there are pending motions to dismiss that would dispose of the Claims entirely if granted. If Respondents' motions to dismiss are denied, Respondents must be afforded the opportunity to engage in discovery and present evidence supporting their positions.
- 8. Moreover, the information before the Commission does not support Claimant's contention that he has proven his Claims and is entitled to judgment in his favor. On the contrary, as more thoroughly set out in the motions to dismiss pending in each case, the

facts show that the Commission lacks jurisdiction, and that Respondents did not violate Claimant's civil rights by enforcing the conditions of his supervised release from prison.

 For the foregoing reasons, Claimant's Motion for Directed Verdict and Motion for Summary Judgment should be denied and his Claims should be dismissed in their entirety.

WHEREFORE, Respondents ADC and ACC respectfully request that Claimant's Claims be dismissed and for all other relief to which they may be entitled.
