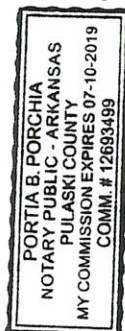

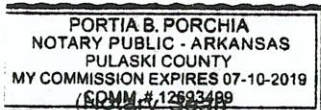

Explanation: With the Wonderful Name of Almighty God (Allah) To Whom All Praises Are Due Forever! Most Gracious, Most Merciful!

On the Sunday morning of August 21, 2016 (08/21/16), at approximately 5:45 am, after I left
Fajr prayer, I was driving up Asher Avenue and I came to where Asher Avenue divides into
Roosevelt Street. I was in front of Performance Radiator Auto Parts Shop located at 3901 Asher
Avenue, when I hit a pothole and my front tire on the passenger's side. The sound was so loud
it frightened me. It should be noted that I am a Senior Citizen, born 12/02/47. I am 69 years old.
I pulled over into the liquor store lot to assess the damage. My tire was destroyed, and the tire
rim was bent. A friend of mine saw me at the liquor store and came to assist me. We changed
the tire, and I drove home on a donut tire. On Monday morning around 9:00 am I went to
Legacy Wheels and Tires, LLC at 5501 South University. It should be noted that I stopped to take
a picture of the pothole, but it had been repaired. There may be record of others hitting the
same pothole. Attached are copies of all the monetary expenses that I have incurred. This
amount does not include loss of transportation for two or three days at a time because the
parts I needed had to be ordered. Those dates were 9/17/16 to 9/19/16 plus two other
occasions. Also attached is a receipt from Coleman and Son Automotive. Mr. Coleman had to
reset the Triton system because the back end of my car was so low that I wouldn't be able to
pull onto any lot. I paid \$302.40 (see attached exhibits 1 through 6). The total cost to me, the
claimant, is \$1,817.21. Wherefore the complainant, Kasib Tauheed Bilal, respectfully requests
the honorable commission to please reimburse Bilal for his damages to his vehicle. Also Bilal
requests payment for time lost, and any and all further relief this Commission deems just and
proper. It should also be noted that the rim for my car is on order now priced at \$420.00. This
would raise my total damages to the amount of \$2,237.21.





Pursuant to your letter of April 3, 2017, Respondent submits the following with regard to the scheduled hearing of this matter on June 15, 2017:

Respondent's Brief

The Claimant reports that he received damage to his vehicle when he hit a pothole in front of Performance Radiator Auto Parts Shop at the intersection of Asher Avenue and Roosevelt Roads in Little Rock. This occurred on Sunday, August 21, 2016. The Claims Commission has previously heard a claim involving the same pothole on the same date, *Lahoma Davis v. AHTD*, Claim No. 17-0160-CC. At that hearing on December 15, 2016, the Respondent's Area Maintenance Supervisor testified that the Respondent had no prior knowledge of the pothole prior to the incident; the Respondent marked the area after being informed on the date of the incident; and, that the pothole was repaired the next day after the incident. The Commission unanimously denied and dismissed the claim due to no fault of the Respondent, stating, "The Claimant failed to prove by a preponderance of the evidence any liability on the part of the Respondent." The Commission should rule the same in this case. It is impossible to predict when and where a pothole will develop, therefore encountering a pothole is a risk assumed by the public in general as part of travel. Historically and legally, the Commission will not award damages caused by a pothole unless a Claimant can show some negligence on the part of the respondent. Such proof of negligence must generally include facts to indicate that the respondent had prior knowledge of the pothole, yet the respondent failed to respond within a reasonable amount of time to repair the pothole. 
Based upon the pleadings, testimony, and other evidence, the Claims Commission hereby unanimously finds as follows:



6. As such, Claimant has failed to prove any liability on the part of the Respondent. Claimant's claim is DENIED and DISMISSED.



Respondent's witness corroborated Claimant's testimony and stated that he dispatched an employee to fix the pothole the same day that he received notification of the pothole. As such, the Claims Commission held that Claimant did not prove liability on the part of Respondent.

3. Claimant's motion for reconsideration fails to set forth new or additional evidence not available to Claimant at the time of the hearing. As such, pursuant to Rule 7.1 of the Claims Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure, Claimant's motion for reconsideration is DENIED, and the June 28, 2017, Claims Commission order remains in effect.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
