Pursuant to your letter of April 3, 2017, Respondent submits the following with regard to the scheduled hearing of this matter on June 15, 2017:

#### Respondent's Brief

The Claimant reports that he received damage to his vehicle when he hit a pothole in front of Performance Radiator Auto Parts Shop at the intersection of Asher Avenue and Roosevelt Roads in Little Rock. This occurred on Sunday, August 21, 2016. The Claims Commission has previously heard a claim involving the same pothole on the same date, Lahoma Davis v. AHTD, Claim No. 17-0160-CC. At that hearing on December 15, 2016, the Respondent's Area Maintenance Supervisor testified that the Respondent had no prior knowledge of the pothole prior to the incident; the Respondent marked the area after being informed on the date of the incident; and, that the pothole was repaired the next day after the incident. The Commission unanimously denied and dismissed the claim due to no fault of the Respondent, stating, "The Claimant failed to prove by a preponderance of the evidence any liability on the part of the Respondent." #### <u>ORDER</u>

Now before the Arkansas State Claims Commission (the "Claims Commission") is the claim of Kasib Tauheed Bilal (the "Claimant") against the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (the "Respondent"). At the hearing held on June 15, 2017, Claimant appeared *pro se*. David Dawson appeared on behalf of Respondent.

Based upon the pleadings, testimony, and other evidence, the Claims Commission hereby unanimously finds as follows:

- 1. The Claims Commission has jurisdiction over this claim pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 19-10-204.
- 2. Claimant states in his claim that on August 21, 2016, Claimant's vehicle struck a pothole on Asher Avenue, which damaged his tire and tire rim and caused other damage to his vehicle. Claimant seeks \$2,237.21 in damages.
- 3. Respondent filed an answer denying liability. In that answer, Respondent affirmatively plead that unless Claimant can show negligence on the part of the Respondent, including both prior knowledge of the pothole by Respondent and a failure to respond within a reasonable amount of time, a damage award is not proper.
- 4. Claimant offered testimony that the pothole was fixed on the same day that his vehicle hit the pothole. Claimant testified that when he went to look at the pothole the following day, it had already been repaired.

- 5. Respondent's witness offered similar testimony that he was notified of the pothole on the same day that Claimant's vehicle struck it. The witness testified that he promptly dispatched an employee to fix the pothole.
- 6. As such, Claimant has failed to prove any liability on the part of the Respondent. Claimant's claim is DENIED and DISMISSED.

IT IS SO ORDERED.



#### ORDER

Now before the Arkansas State Claims Commission (the "Claims Commission") is the motion filed by Kasib Tauheed Bilal (the "Claimant") for reconsideration of the June 28, 2017, order entered by the Claims Commission denying and dismissing Claimant's claim against the Arkansas Department of Transportation f/k/a Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (the "Respondent").

Based upon the pleadings, testimony, and other evidence, the Claims Commission hereby unanimously finds as follows:

- 1. The Claims Commission has jurisdiction over this claim pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 19-10-204.
- 2. On June 28, 2017, the Claims Commission entered an order denying and dismissing Claimant's claim. The Claims Commission held that Claimant's testimony that the pothole was fixed the same day that his vehicle hit the pothole was evidence that the Respondent repaired the pothole within a reasonable amount of time. Respondent's witness corroborated Claimant's testimony and stated that he dispatched an employee to fix the pothole the same day that he received notification of the pothole. As such, the Claims Commission held that Claimant did not prove liability on the part of Respondent.

3. Claimant's motion for reconsideration fails to set forth new or additional evidence not available to Claimant at the time of the hearing. As such, pursuant to Rule 7.1 of the Claims Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure, Claimant's motion for reconsideration is DENIED, and the June 28, 2017, Claims Commission order remains in effect.
