AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - DIVISION OF AGING, ADULT, AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR.

Amend Senate Bill No. 102 as engrossed, \$3/27/19 (version: 03/27/2019 03:22:33 PM)

On page 19, immediately following SECTION 28, insert the following:

- SECTION 29. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD OF UNOBLIGATED GENERAL REVENUE FUNDS FOR SENIOR CITIZEN CENTERS. (a) On June 30, 2019, or as soon as is practicable to determine funds available as authorized in this Section, and each fiscal year thereafter the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall cause to be transferred on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and Auditor of State the balance of unobligated general revenue funds, excluding funds carried forward for other purposes, remaining in the Fund or Fund Accounts and the corresponding paying account as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, as set out in subsection (b) herein, to the Department of Human Services - Division of Aging, Adult, and Behavioral Health Services paying account to be used exclusively for the disbursement of funds for Senior Citizen Centers in the amount of recouped and recovered general revenue not to exceed five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).
- (b) Any unobligated general revenue, excluding funds carried forward for other purposes, remaining in the following Fund or Fund Accounts and the corresponding paying accounts at the end of the Fiscal Year that would normally be transferred into the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund as recouped or recovered General Revenue shall be transferred as authorized in subsection (a) herein:
 - (1) Department of Human Services Administration Fund Account;
 - Children and Family Services Fund Account;
 - (3) Child Care and Early Childhood Education Fund Account;
 - (4) Youth Services Fund Account;
 - (5) Developmental Disabilities Services Fund Account;
 - (6) Medical Services Fund Account;
 - (7) Behavioral Health Services Fund Account;
 - (8) State Services for the Blind Fund Account;

- (9) County Operations Fund Account; and
- (10) Provider Services and Quality Assurance Fund Account.
- (c)(1) Any general revenue recouped or recovered as authorized in subsections (a) and (b) herein shall be carried forward to the following fiscal year for Senior Citizen Centers and shall be distributed in the same manner as the funding formula requirements set out in the federal Older Americans Act funding law.
- (2) The additional funding provided by this provision shall supplement and not supplant any monies currently funding services for Senior Citizen Centers.
- (d) Should additional funding provided for in subsections (a) and (b) herein be insufficient to provide for the full five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) authorized, the increases shall be provided to the extent that general revenue is recouped and carried forward.
- (e)(1) The Department of Human Services shall provide a written report to the Department of Finance and Administration Budget Office, the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee the total amount of general revenue carried forward and distributed as set forth in this section no later than thirty (30) days prior to the time the Department presents its budget request to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.
- (2) The Department of Finance and Administration shall include all information obtained in subsection (e)(1) herein in the budget manual submitted to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee for the Department."

On page 19, delete SECTION 31 in its entirety and insert the following:

SECTION 31. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided; with the exception that Sections 23 and 29 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019, with the exception that Sections 23 and 29 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval, could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019; with the exception that Sections 23 and 29 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval."

SECTION 10. EXTRA HELP - COMMISSION FOR PARENT COUNSEL. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission - Commission for Parent Counsel for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: fourteen (14) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 11. APPROPRIATION - COMMISSION FOR PARENT COUNSEL. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Public Defender Commission, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services, operating expenses and parent counsel refunds/reimbursements of the Commission for Parent Counsel for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, the following:

SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. INDIGENT PARENT COUNSEL REPRESENTATION. The Commission for Parent Counsel shall have the authority to use the appropriation provided in line item Parent Counsel Reimbursements of the Parent Counsel Program appropriation herein for the purpose of entering into independent professional service contracts on a full-time or part-time basis with attorneys who are qualified to provide counsel for indigent parents in dependency-neglect cases.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL OR TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER PROVISION — LINE ITEMS - COMMISSION FOR PARENT COUNSEL. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the Arkansas Public Defender Commission is authorized to transfer appropriation, with the exception of Personal Services Matching, between the line items authorized herein for the Commission for Parent Counsel, to best utilize resources to meet the needs of the Parent Counsel's clientele.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE
ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

EXTRA HELP EXEMPTION - COMMISSION FOR PARENT COUNSEL. Extra Help positions
authorized herein for the Commission for Parent Counsel are specifically
exempt from limitation of hours. Employees currently working on a part-time
basis may be utilized concurrently as Extra Help within the agency. The
total amount of compensation for part-time and Extra Help work combined
cannot exceed the maximum compensation allowed for a grade GS11 as authorized
in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. Flexibility is needed to

allow for non-traditional work schedules that may be necessary to accommodate the schedule of the individual being represented. Attorneys utilized as Extra Help employees are not prevented from having other employment.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

SECTION 15. Arkansas Code § 9-27-703 is amended to read as follows: 9-27-703. Commission for Parent Counsel.

- (f)(1) <u>General Financial</u> support staff, <u>financial data entry staff and</u> facilities, and operating assistance for the Commission for Parent Counsel shall be provided by the <u>Administrative Office of the Courts</u> <u>Arkansas Public Defender Commission</u> from funds that are specifically appropriated for that purpose by the General Assembly.
- (2) However, the office Arkansas Public Defender Commission shall not have oversight responsibility or authority over the commission Commission for Parent Counsel except when the commission requests that the office facilitate any contract with an attorney who has been approved for contract by the commission.
 - (3) Under no circumstances shall the:
- (A) Commission for Parent Counsel exercise oversight of the Executive Director of the Arkansas Public Defender Commission;
- (B) Arkansas Public Defender Commission exercise oversight of the Executive Director of the Commission for Parent Counsel; and
- (C) Either Executive Director of the Arkansas Public Defender

 Commission of the Commission for Parent Counsel be under the oversight of the other executive director.
- SECTION 16. Arkansas Code § 9-27-704 is amended to read as follows: 9-27-704. Power and duties of the Commission for Parent Counsel - Funding Formula - Liability.
- (a)(2) The Commission for Parent Counsel may employee or enter into independent professional service contracts with attorneys to represent a parent at the trial court level as well as at the appellate level.
- (d) Neither the Administrative Office of the Courts Arkansas Public

 Defender Commission nor the Commission for Parent Counsel is liable directly or indirectly to any attorney or to the Arkansas State Claims Commission for the payment of attorney's fees or expenses except to the extent specific funding is appropriated and available for the purpose of providing indigent parent counsel in dependency-neglect cases."
