Amend House Bill No. 1187 as engrossed, H1/27/21 (version: 01/27/2021 2:23:37 PM)

Insert an additional SECTION immediately following SECTION 15 to read as follows:

" SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>PERMANENT GIFT SHOP. The Arkansas Secretary of State shall operate a gift</u> shop to be permanently located in a space on the first floor of the State Capitol Building. It shall be the duty of the Secretary of State to maintain a space on the first floor of the State Capitol Building for the use of a gift shop. The Arkansas Secretary of State is prohibited from removing a gift shop from the first floor of the State Capitol Building or to nullify or void the provisions of this section. A space on the first floor of the State Capitol Building shall be the only location for the Arkansas Secretary of State gift shop operations and shall be the only location items of the Arkansas Secretary of State gift shop are sold to the public."

1 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 3 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 4 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 5 Committee, the Agency is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line 6 item authorized in Operations appropriation to any other line item authorized 7 in Operations appropriation.

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
9 <u>2021</u> through June 30, 2021 <u>2022</u>.

11 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. STATE CAPITOL POLICE. In the event that sufficient revenues, in the judgment of 13 14 the Secretary of State exist, the Secretary is hereby authorized to make 15 additional salary payments from such funds to those employees who have 16 attained law enforcement certification above the basic certificate level, as 17 defined by the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards. It is the 18 intent of this Section that such payment shall be optional, at the discretion 19 of the Secretary, dependent on sufficient revenues and shall not be 20 implemented using funds specifically set aside for other programs within the 21 Department.

22 Employees shall be eligible for all or a portion of additional salary 23 payments scheduled as follows:

24	I.	General Certificate	-	\$	300	annually
25	II.	Intermediate Certificate	-	\$	600	annually
26	III.	Advanced Certificate	-	\$	900	annually
27	IV.	Senior Certificate	-	\$1	, 200	annually

Payment of such funds may be made monthly, quarterly, semiannually or annually depending upon the availability of revenues and shall be restricted to the following classifications:

- 31 1. Sec. of State Capitol Police Chief
- 32 2. Sec. of State Police Sergeant

33 3. Sec. of State Corporal

34 4. Sec. of State Capitol Police Captain

35 Payments made under this Section which are awarded as partial or lump sum 36 payments shall not be considered as salary for purposes of retirement

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benefits but shall be subject to withholding of all applicable federal and
 state taxes. Payments made under this Section shall not be construed as
 exceeding the maximum annual salary of the employee.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2020
5 <u>2021</u> through June 30, 2021 <u>2022</u>.

7 SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 8 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 9 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 10 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 12 13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 14 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

17 SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 18 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 19 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 20 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 21 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 22 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 23 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 24 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 25

26 SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 27 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 28 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2021 is essential to the operation of 29 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided; with the exception that Section 13 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from 31 32 and after the date of its passage and approval; and that in the event of an 33 extension of the Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond 34 July 1, 2021, with the exception that Section 13 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval, could 35 36 work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of

AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR.

Amendment No. ____ to House Bill No. 1080

Amend House Bill No. 1080 as originally introduced:

Insert a new Section immediately following Section 12 to read as follows: "

SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. (A) In passing Act 725 during the 2015 Regular Session, the Ninetieth Arkansas General Assembly found and determined that the costs that drive public utility rates are changing; that public utilities need to have procedures that permit their rates to change in response to those changing conditions; that there is a need to address the allocation of costs and design of rates; that there is a need to maintain stable rates and to mitigate the magnitude of future rate changes; and that affordable electricity and natural gas encourage economic activity within the state and benefit the state's industries to increase the number of available jobs and to attract new businesses and industries to the state. The Arkansas General Assembly recognized that this regulatory reform was required to enable electric and natural gas utilities to make the investments necessary to maintain safe and reliable service at reasonable rates. In order to ensure Act 725 of 2015 is implemented in accordance with Legislative intent, the Arkansas General Assembly directs that the Arkansas Public Service Commission implement the Act in accordance with this special language.

(B)(i) When calculating the adjustment to net any differences under §23-4-1206(e)(1) the Arkansas Public Service Commission shall include the actual

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historical year change in revenue for the same prior period projected year being netted.

(ii) For the purposes of calculating the adjustment to net any differences under §23-4-1206(e)(1), the Arkansas Public Service Commission shall ensure that the revenue received for the historical year shall be comprised of: (1) prior formula rate review test period changes in revenue, (2) netting revenue from a prior formula rate review test period and (3) prior projected year revenue for the year being netted, in order to isolate the change in revenue for the same prior projected year being netted.

(iii) The Arkansas Public Service Commission shall calculate an adjustment to net any differences under §23-4-1206(e)(1) by calculating the differences between the prior formula rate review test period changes in revenue and the prior projected year revenue for the year being netted.

(C) If the prior formula rate review test period change in revenue being netted was limited by the provisions of §23-4-1207(d)(2), the Arkansas Public Service Commission shall ensure that the revenue recovered shall be either: (i) applied first to any revenue amounts remaining from the prior approved formula rate review test periods specified in (B)(ii), second to the netting adjustment specified in (B)(ii), and last to the prior projected year revenue for the year being netted specified in (B)(ii); or

(ii) proportioned to (1) the netting adjustment specified in (B)(ii), and (2) the prior projected year revenue for the year being netted based upon the prior formula rate review test period change in revenue being netted under (B) before the provisions of §23-4-1207(d)(2) were applied.

(D)(i) A utility may choose to apply either (C)(i) or (C)(ii) for the term of an approved formula rate review approved under §23-4-1208(a)(1) and the Arkansas Public Service Commission shall authorize the utility to use such chosen methodology. The authorized methodology shall remain in effect for the duration of the approved term under §23-4-1208(a)(1).

(ii) This subsection shall apply to any formula rate review approved and in effect under §23-4-1208(a)(1) since the passage of Act 725 of the 2015 Regular Session on March 27, 2015.

(iii) For any extension of the term of an approved formula rate review requested under §23-4-1208(a)(2), the utility may propose to follow either (C)(i) or (C)(ii). Upon a public interest determination, the Arkansas Public Service Commission shall authorize a utility to follow either (C)(i) or

(C)(ii) for the extension of the term of the formula rate review."

3 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 5 CONTINGENCY RESTRICTION - TAX DIVISION. In the event additional 6 appropriations become necessary that are not authorized or contemplated in 7 the Tax Division appropriation of this Act and specific cases, situations, 8 and/or programs make it necessary that the Arkansas Public Service Commission 9 - Tax Division receives additional appropriations to carry out the objectives 10 of the Division, the Chairman of the Arkansas Public Service Commission is 11 hereby authorized to request the approval of the Governor and the Chief 12 Fiscal Officer of the State for transfers of the appropriations provided in the Contingency line item of the Tax Division appropriation of this Act to 13 14 other line items within the Tax Division appropriation. In no event shall 15 the transfers in any fiscal year exceed the appropriations provided in the 16 Contingency line item of the Tax Division appropriation of this Act. The 17 Governor may approve or modify such request for transfer of appropriations as 18 in his or her judgment he or she deems necessary, and shall seek prior review 19 and approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 20 and inform the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Upon notification, the 21 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall direct the State Auditor to process 22 said transfer upon his or her books in accordance with the provisions as set 23 out herein.

24 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 25 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 26 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 27 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 28 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 29 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 30 has determined that the Public Service Commission - Tax Division may operate 31 more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Public Service 32 Commission - Tax Division authorizing broad powers under this Section. 33 Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly 34 maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or 35 Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of 36 approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a

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severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the
 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a
 court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.
