SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PAROLE/PROBATION OFFICERS HIRING. (i) It is the intent of the General Assembly to provide funding and positions to the Department of Community Correction to ensure the agency employs a sufficient number of Parole/Probation Officers to reduce the number of cases per officer. (ii) The Department of Community Correction shall report quarterly to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee regarding the hiring status and caseload of DCC Parole/Probation Officers. The report shall include, but not limited to, the number of vacant Parole/Probation Officer positions, the number and date of Parole/Probation Officers, Parole/Probation Area Managers, and Parole/Probation Assistant Area Manager hired after July 1, 2017 and the total number of cases Parole/Probation Officer oversees.

(iii) In order to ensure a reduction in case load, the Department of Community Correction shall have hired no less than fifteen (15) new positions as listed in (ii) herein by December 31, 2017 and no less than a total of twenty (20) new positions as listed in (ii) herein by March 31, 2018. (iv) If the Department fails to meet the provisions in (iii) herein then the Department Director shall provide written justification to the Governor, Speaker of the House, Senate Pro Tempore and testify before the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee on why the Department was unable to fulfill this requirement and provide a timeline showing the detail of the action the Department will implement to fulfill the requirement of (iii) herein.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018."
