The Arkansas Securities Department occasionally issues refund checks to registrants for overpayments in filing fees. The refunds are issued out of an ASD bank account at Simmons Bank. Once refunds are issued, an entry is entered in AASIS to record the refund. The annual appropriation for the entry to record the refunds is \$50,000, and additional appropriation is needed to record a \$48,000 refund done for 10 security holder exemptions that were filed incorrectly through the electronic filing system.

The Arkansas Securities Department requests additional appropriation in the amount of \$48,000 in Commitment Item 14, Refunds/Reimbursements, Fund 1530000, Fund Center C67, and Business Area 0410 for FY'23 to allow us to properly record the entry in AASIS...

Dear Mr. Brech:

The Arkansas Department of Parks, Heritage and Tourism, Parks Division, is requesting a cash fund increase for FY23 maintenance and operations. The additional appropriation in M&O is required to ensure overall facility operations and to provide customers with the services they are accustomed to receiving when visiting our 52 park and museum locations across the state.

The agency is requesting an increase of \$1,500,000 in Commitment Item 02 M&O, Fund NPT0104, Fund Center 986 and Business Area 0900. This request became necessary due to unanticipated inflationary cost, expense carryover from the previous fiscal year (supply chain delays), and repairs associated with the required Lake Catherine State Park closure. Cumulatively, these issues reduced the current M&O appropriation faster than planned.

Fortunately, due to increased visitation and sales, ADPHT has sufficient cash revenues to increase this commitment line item. Respectfully, we are asking that the additional appropriation request be placed on the next PEER Committee agenda.
