This transfer is necessary due to legislative changes per Act 702 of 2019 requiring the transfer of the Arkansas Wireless Information Network (AWIN) program from the Department of Information Systems (DIS) and the Department of Arkansas State Police (ASP) to the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management, effective July 1. The FY20 budget from ASP which transferred to ADEM of this program was established only in the Operating Expenses line item. Technology is advancing at a rate that makes training for AWIN staff essential in order to further their knowledge and skills as well as to obtain information on future changes to technology affecting communications. Further, in order to become fully integrated as part of the Division of Emergency Management, it is important to be able to travel to meetings and conferences related to providing emergency services. FY2019 Actual Expenditures are reflected in ASP's "Arkansas Wireless Information Network (AWIN) - General Revenue" appropriation in Act 224 of 2018, Section 11.
