Dear Mr. Bleed:

The Arkansas Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism, Capitol Zoning District Commission (CZDC), request the establishment of a cash fund appropriation for FY2021. CZDC periodically receives funds from civil fines levied by the Commission. The authority for such fines comes from the Alternative Sanctions section of the Administrative Procedures Act (ACA 25-15-217 (b)1).

The Department is approved for the establishment of a cash fund appropriation in our FY21-FY23 Biennial Budget. However, CDZC is currently in receipt of funds for fines recently levied and anticipates the receipt of additional fines in the upcoming weeks.

The department is requesting a cash fund appropriation of \$2,000 in the Maintenance and Operations (5020002) Commitment Item, Fund NCZ0000, Fund Center Z86, and Business Area 0315 for FY2021 to cover the receipt of these funds. This is the same amount requested in the biennium and the FY21-FY23 approval will serve as the continuation of this fund.
