Boehringer Ingelheim

State of Arkansas v. Boehringer Ingelheim Pharmaceuticals, Inc. - Counsel for the Attorney General worked with BIPI to obtain a Consent Judgement for conducting off-label marketing of Atrovent, Combivent, Agrrenox, and Micardis.

Grand River Enterprises:

State of Arkansas v. Grand River Enterprises — Counsel for the Attorney General worked with Grand River to obtain a settlement agreement for noncompliance with Arkansas's tobacco statutes.

Lenovo (United States, Inc.)

State of Arkansas v. Lenovo, Inc. - Counsel for the Attorney General worked with Lenovo and obtained a Consent Decree for pre-installing software that enabled adware on consumers' laptop computers that gave access to sensitive information transmitted on the Internet.

Yolanda Hartin:

State of Arkansas v. Yovana Hartin dba Orientacion Latina - Counsel for the Attorney General worked with Yovana Hartin's counsel to obtain a consent judgement resolving Yovana Hartin's unconscionable business practices.

Ridge Mart Inc.

State of Arkansas v. Ridge Mart, Inc. - Counsel for the Attorney General worked with Ridge Mart Inc. to obtain a settlement agreement for noncompliance with Arkansas's tobacco statutes.
