The University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences respectfully requests allotment of funds to address the staffing and bed shortages and additional costs providing COVID-19 treatment per the AR ARPA Proposal approved by the Arkansas Legislative Council on August 9, 2021.

Formula-Based Allotment to Attain and Retain Frontline Healthcare Workers

UAMS requests an amount equal to the full amount of the hospital's available formula-based funding totaling:

450 licensed Medicare beds times \$9,000 for a total request of \$4,050,000.

COVIDComm Receiving Hospital Add-on Payments

UAMS participated as a receiving hospital of COVID-19 positive patients and therefore is requesting funding under the COVIDComm receiving hospital transfer system totaling:
450 licensed Medicare beds times \$2,500 for a total request of \$1,125,000.

Monoclonal Antibody Administration Add-on Payments

UAMS administered monoclonal antibodies to COVID-19 positive patients and therefore is requesting funding under the MAB administration add-on payments totaling:

450 licensed Medicare beds times \$1,000 for a total request of \$450,000.
