Agency Purpose of Grant & Funding Percentages

 Department of Health -Paul Coverdell National Acute Stroke Registry The Arkansas Department of Health (ADH) Arkansas Stroke Registry program has been awarded a Paul Coverdell National Acute Stroke Program grant. The funding is expected to total \$1,800,000 over three years. Activities will include integration of data collection systems through the state's hospital and emergency medical services (EMS) data collection systems through linkage using Stroke Band Identification numbers. Community outreach through partnerships with various organizations including hospitals, EMS, the Arkansas Stroke Task Force, and the American Heart Association, University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS) Institute for Digital Health (IDHI), Arkansas Minority Health Commission (AMHC), and ADH Tobacco Cessation Branch. Identification of gaps, improve efficiency of care within emergency medical services and hospital settings will be implemented through performance monitoring, transitions of care (TOC) quality improvement plans, use of the mobile communications application, state-based stroke designation, and continuous quality improvement. Increase use of standards of care through the EMS and TOC toolkits, conferences, and webinars for improved patient hand-off and TOC.

 Department of Parks, Heritage & Tourism -Arkansas Heritage Division The Arkansas State Archives (ASA) proposes to select, digitize and make available to the Library of Congress (LOC) a third cycle of approximately 100,000 pages of newspapers, published within Arkansas between 1819 and 1925, as part of the National Digital Newspaper Program (NDNP). The project will build upon the success of the first two cycles of this project, which have resulted in nearly 200,000 pages of historic newspapers from the collections of the Arkansas State Archives being made available on the LOC's Chronicling America website. The Mississippi Department of Archives and History (MDAH) served as technical partners on Cycles I and II; our successful collaboration with them has prepared the ASA to continue participation in the NDNP, assuming responsibility for the aspects of the work formerly addressed by the MDAH.
