Dear Senator Maloch and Representative Meeks:

The State of Arkansas has received a check in the amount of \$5,275,674.33 which represents the net settlement proceeds from a bankruptcy claim made on behalf of the Arkansas Building Authority against W.R. Grace & Company.

The Department of Finance and Administration (DFA) has been charged with disbursing the settlement proceeds. As Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, I am requesting cash appropriation for fiscal year 2015 on behalf of the state agencies listed below who own the buildings affected by the asbestos lawsuit. The determination was made to return the funding to the agency since they provide the maintenance and support for the building. In addition, some agencies will require the creation of a new Cash in Treasury fund.

The Department of Human Services (DHS) will be receiving \$1,522,065.68 from the settlement. DHS has sufficient appropriation in their Various Building Construction (1DE) appropriation to use the funds.

Dear Mr. Sharp:

By this letter, I am requesting the continuation of a \$500,000 Treasury Cash Fund Appropriation for rebates under the Gaseous Fuels Rebate* Program within the Arkansas Energy Office (AEO). The funding for this program has come via a grant from the Northwest Arkansas Economic Development District (NWAEDD) which received funding from the 89th General Assembly for funding projects in Northwest Arkansas.

The NWAEDD has expressed a desire to add a portion of the funding they received from the 89th General Assembly to the AEO's funding for the statewide Gaseous Fuels Program in order help the AEO in their efforts to establish a statewide network of alternative fuel filling stations and to offer rebates to vehicle owners who wish to convert to clean burning fuels on private and fleet vehicles.

There are currently seven (7) CNG stations throughout the state (Ft. Smith, Conway (2), North Little Rock, Jonesboro, and Damascus). Of these seven, the AEO has already provided funding through grants from American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funding. The AEO also has plans to award rebate funding to two (2) additional stations (Springdale and West Memphis) from 89th Session General Improvement Funds. The funding herein contemplated will allow for funding a third station in Springdale making a total of ten (10) stations in the statewide network. The funding herein contemplated will also allow immediate implementation of the vehicle conversion rebate program.

The grants/rebates to establish an alternative fuel filling station are based on a competitive scoring process. The stations already established were those that ranked highest on the competitive scoring process. The stations now contemplated as being funded are those that have scored highest of the remaining applicants. The AEO has a desire to continue funding additional stations in other areas of the state as funds become available to those stations that rank next highest on the ranking system.

The rebates allowed under the program are for \$4,500 or fifty percent (50%) of the conversion cost, whichever is the lesser, for vehicles and \$400,000 or 75 percent (75%) of the construction cost, whichever is the lesser, for refueling stations.

The rebates are part of the requirements of Act 532 of 2013 for the statewide program. The AEO received \$1,050,000 total funding from the 89th General Assembly for refueling stations and vehicle conversion. After giving the rebates for the two refueling stations at Springdale and West Memphis, only minimal funding remains available for the vehicle conversion part of the program. The appropriation herein requested will allow the AEO to strengthen the vehicle conversion part of the rebate program at this time instead of having to wait for possible funding from future legislative actions.

Our request is somewhat complicated because the vehicle rebate program is ready to begin now, and rebates will be subject to payment immediately upon establishment of the appropriation herein requested, however, the rebates for the refueling station contemplated herein will not be needed until sometime after July 1, 2014.

For these reasons, we needed to establish the appropriation in FY '14 which was accomplished via a similar request, reviewed by the Performance Evaluation and Expenditure Review (PEER) Committee at the May 8, 2014 meeting. Now, we need to reestablish the appropriation for next fiscal year (FY '15) in order to expend any remaining balance of the program not expended in FY '15.

Please let me know if there is anything else I need to supply to meet the needs of the Office of Budget, or the PEER subcommittee.

The Department of Finance and Administration, Office of State Procurement continues to work with a third party contractor to accomplish the following:

- 1. First, the material master data used in the AASIS system will be reviewed and redefined using a standardized coding structure. The existing descriptions used to define the goods and services purchased by the State will be replaced by those used in the standards defined by the National Institute of Governmental Purchasing (NIGP).
- 2. Secondly, an independent review and assessment of the State's purchasing business processes. will be performed. This will be an analysis of the processes, procedures and organization currently in place and a comparison to those of peer organizations in other states. This comparison will be used to establish a benchmark, based on industry best practices, from which an improvement plan can be developed.
- 3. Finally, a plan to improve current procurement processes will be developed. A gap analysis comparing current processes to the future state defined in the benchmarking task will be performed. A transition plan will be developed to bridge the gap between the current state and the goals of the best practices identified in the assessment



Dear Governor Beebe,

The Arkansas Legislature passed Act 217 of 1969 making the Arkansas Natural Resources Commission (ANRC) responsible for water planning at the state level and the development of the first State Water Plan. Since its completion and publication in 1975 and its most recent update in 1985, the Plan has served as a guide for the development of land and water resources.

The 88th General Assembly enacted Act 749 of 2011 to declare public policy promoting the efficient use of water for the benefit of the people and wildlife of Arkansas and to encourage best management practices and reliable data to provide scientific methods for managing and conserving the State's water resources for water use. The ANRC is now in the process of undertaking a substantial revision and update of the Arkansas Water Plan.

A Memorandum of Agreement dated December 14, 2011, between the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission (AGFC) and the ANRC states that the AGFC will contribute up to \$1 million to the ANRC in support of this major effort. To date, 100% of this commitment has been received by the Arkansas Natural Resources Commission.

With this letter, I request to establish additional cash appropriation of \$1million (\$800,000 for Professional Fees and \$200,000 for Operating Expenses) within the Arkansas Natural Resources Cash appropriation to enable the ANRC to utilize the additional funds received from the AGFC. The AASIS Coding includes: Business Area 0455, Functional Area COMM, Funds Center 420, Fund NSW0115, and Cost Center 336612.

This resulted in an increase of approximately \$14,000. The AALCB entered into an agreement with INA to develop and maintain a website which included an annual \$2,100 annual support fee.

Additional Conference & Travel appropriation is needed to continue the Board's annual Day with Appraisers continuing education seminar for approximately 200 Arkansas real property appraisers. This increase is for meeting room(s) rental, speakers' fees and related expenses, printing, and other materials. In summary, the AALCB requests additional appropriation as follows:

Please consider this letter as a request for additional funds in our Professional Fees Account. We have been authorized to budget \$8,300 in commitment item 5060010. We are asking for an increase of \$3,700.00, making a total of \$12,000 for Professional Fees. The reasons are:

(1) The Board Administrator's duties have heavily increased. The board had to request a cash increase letter last year to be able to pay the Administrator, due to her increased workload. She is now making \$9,000 per year as a contract employee with \$1,000 added into the budget for her travel expense. The other \$2,000 requested is to cover other professional services such as a stenographer for court hearings, website fees to Information Network of AR or any other unexpected professional service that might arise.

We have been authorized to budget \$9,000 in commitment item 5020002 (Operating Expenses). We are asking for an increase of \$3,000. The reason is:

(2) Our travel expenses have increased due to 13 full-time board members traveling from all over the state to Little Rock. Currently, our budget does not include enough funds to enable them to meet monthly.

As of March, 2013, our Board has been authorized per Act 1249 of 2013 to increase licensing and renewal fees to our Counselors, generating added income. You may review our Certification of Income form that has been submitted to DF&A in the annual operations plan. Our total funding should be approximately \$64,000 to cover a two year period. We are requesting \$31,996 for the fiscal year of 2014-2015.
