The Arkansas Techer Retirement System requests a cash fund appropriation increase in the amount of \$16,000,000 from the DFA Cash Fund Holding Account for Fiscal Year 2016.

Current FY2016 trends indicate that the amount of ATRS payouts to beneficiaries will outpace available appropriation. We request the increase in appropriation for Non-Employee Benefits in order to meet all projected benefit payout obligations for FY2016.

Dear Mr. Baird:

The ADVA recently received \$170,000 cash from the Attorney General's Settlement Fund to assist the agency in funding some costs of opening the new regional Veteran service offices and the new State Veterans Home at North Little Rock. We are therefore respectfully requesting \$170,000 in supplemental FY16 cash appropriation for these expenditures.

Commitment Item - (512:00:11) Capital Outlay - \$85,000

We are requesting cash appropriation for purchase of the following items: \$50,000 for the purchase of two vehicles for regional Veteran Service Officers; \$24,000 for the purchase of battery-powered vehicles for the new State Veterans Home at North Little Rock; and \$11,000 for the purchase of stationary therapy bicycles for the new Home.

Commitment Item - (502:00:02) Operating Expenses - \$85,000

We are requesting \$85,000 in cash appropriation for various one-time costs associated with the opening of the new State Veterans Home at North Little Rock and the regional Veterans Service offices, including \$45,000 for initial development costs of a hosted website.

Income Certification

FY16 certified income is \$170,000 for the above appropriation requests (check# 3909, from the Office of the Attorney General's Settlement Fund, deposited to fund NVA0100, AASIS document# 28128152 dated 12/22/2015). Once the new fund is setup for segregation of the above costs, the agency will request a transfer of \$170,000 from NVA0100 to the new fund.
