Arkansas Code § 5-73-311(a)(2), concerning the fees for a license to carry a concealed handgun, is amended to read as follows: (2) A nonrefundable license fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) fifty dollars (\$50.00), except that the nonrefundable license fee is fifty dollars (\$50.00) twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) if the applicant is sixty-five (65) years of age or older;"

22	SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the					
23	Department of Arkansas State Police for the 2018-2019 fiscal year, the

- 1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS
- 2 WIRELESS INFORMATION NETWORK. Once the requirements of Arkansas Code §12-8-
- 3 310 are satisfied, the second two million five hundred thousand dollars
- 4 (\$2,500,000) deposited into the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund
- 5 generated by Arkansas Code §27-16-801(a) shall be used for the operations,
- 6 maintenance, equipment and various system requirements and expenses of the
- 7 Department of Arkansas State Police Arkansas Wireless Information Network.
- 8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017 9 2018 through June 30, 2018 2019.

- 11 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. QUARTERLY
- 13 REPORTING. The Department of Arkansas State Police shall on a quarterly basis
- 14 provide to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee a
- 15 report detailing expenditures from the Court Awards Fund of the Confiscated
- 16 Funds Transfer appropriation of this Act. The report shall include the State
- 17 Police division, purpose and amount of expenditures.
- 18 The quarterly reports shall be provided no later than the 15th day of the
- 19 month immediately following the end of each quarter.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017
- 21 2018 through June 30, 2018 2019.

- SECTION 21. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 24 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 25 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 26 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 27 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 28 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 29 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 30 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 31 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

- 33 SECTION 22. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
- 34 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
- 35 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
- 36 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
