"SECTION 33. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. RESTRICTED RESERVE FUND TRANSFER. Effective July 2, 2018, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) from the Restricted Reserve Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts to the Department of Education - Public School Fund for the operation and administration of the Arkansas Better Chance Program."

SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. R.I.S.E. 25 ARKANSAS. The appropriation for the R.I.S.E. Arkansas line item in the 26 Grants and Aid to Local School Districts and Special Programs section of this 27 Act shall be used for the coordination of a statewide reading campaign with 28 community partners, parents, and teachers to establish the importance of 29 30 reading in homes, schools, and communities.

SECTION 33. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
