Page 15, immediately following SECTION 24, insert a new SECTION to read as follows:

- " SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 76, Subchapter 2, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
  - 20-76-216. Restrictions on use of financial assistance.
- (a) Financial assistance granted to a recipient of the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program or its successor program shall be used only to purchase goods and services that are considered essential and necessary for the welfare of the family, including without limitation:
  - (1) Food:
  - (2) Clothing;
  - (3) Housing;
  - (4) Utilities:
  - (5) Child care; and
- (6) Incidentals, including without limitation transportation and medicine or medical supplies or equipment not covered by either the Arkansas Medicaid Program or the health benefit plan of the individual.
- (b) A recipient of the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program or its successor program shall not make a cash withdrawal from an electronic benefit transfer card account that receives financial assistance under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program or its successor program by electronic benefit transfer system.
- (c) The Department of Workforce Services shall adopt and promulgate rules necessary to implement this section, including without limitation rules defining what goods and services constitute "essential and necessary" to implement subsection (a) of this section.
- (d)(1) On or before October 1, 2016, the department shall request a waiver from the federal government to the extent necessary to implement this section.

SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 5, Subchapter 12, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

19-5-1258. Succeed Scholarship Program Fund.

- (a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a miscellaneous fund to be known as the "Succeed Scholarship Program Fund".
  - (b) The fund shall consist of:
    - (1) General revenues as may be provided by law:
  - (2) Donations or bequests received by the Department of Education for the purpose of starting, augmenting, or replenishing the fund; and
    - (3) Other revenues as may be provided by law.
  - (c) The fund shall be used:
    - (1) For the distribution of scholarship payments under § 6-41-801 et seq.; and
    - (2) As may be otherwise provided by law.
