Act No.	Summary of Act and Rule changes	Rule Title	Action Proposed	Promulgation Status
275	Act 275 changed the definition regarding eligible residents and non-residents for in-state tuition rates. It also created exception request procedures for participants exceeding the 120-semester hour limit or six-semester hour drop limit. Act 275 clarified so-usage rules of other tuition assistance programs and simultaneous enrollment at multiple institutions. This rule amendment encapsulates the changes reflected above in Act 275 as well as minor formatting changes.	Arkansas National Guard Tuition Waiver Program	Amend existing rule	Awaiting Secretary approval of final rule. Will submit to BLR by November 15, 2023, to be placed on legislative agenda for December 2023
