Act 595 Monthly Written Updates

Dear Ms. Whittaker:

The Commissioner of State Lands ("COSL") received your email correspondence dated July 21, 2021, regarding Act 595 of 2021 and Arkansas Code Annotated § 25-15-216(a). On behalf of the COSL, I am responding to your correspondence.

It is the position of the COSL that the reporting requirements under Arkansas Code Annotated § 25-15-216 do not legally apply to the COSL; however, the COSL voluntarily complies with the Administrative Procedures Act ("APA") procedures for promulgating its rules and regulations. Based on a thorough review of the legislation enacted during the 2021 Regular Session of the 93<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly, as well as the Administrative Rules Section of the BLR's report to the ALC Administrative Rules Subcommittee entitled "Report on the Acts of the 2021 Regular Session Requiring New Rulemaking," the COSL has identified only one act that requires any rule changes, and rules have already been promulgated to address the required changes.

Act 447 of 2021, effective March 24, 2021, required revisions to implement changes in the practice and procedures relating to the sale of certain tax-delinquent properties. Due to the emergency clause, the COSL first promulgated emergency rules, which were subsequently adopted without change as permanent rules. The final rules were approved by the ALC on August 27, 2021, and have been reported to the Secretary of State and Arkansas State Library.
