(a) A uniformed service member stationed in the State of Arkansas; (b) A uniformed service veteran who resides in or establishes residency in the State of Arkansas; (c) The spouse of: A person listed in subdivision (a) or (b) of this Rule; (i) (ii) A uniformed service member who is assigned a tour of duty that excludes the uniformed service member's spouse from

accompanying the uniformed service member and the spouse<br/>relocates to this state; and(iii) A uniformed service member who is killed or succumbs to his or<br/>her injuries or illness in the line of duty if the spouse<br/>establishes residency in the state.

To qualify for expedited licensure, the applicant must notate his or her status on the application and provide the Division with a copy of the active duty orders or DD214.
