Notes:

- (1) Area and Assistant Area Managers often carry caseloads that include SIS, offenders on annual supervision, caseloads of officers in the Academy, on FLMA, Military Leave, vacancies, etc.
- (2) Special Assignment Officers carry no direct supervision caseloads. 4 officers supervise Community Service Work Crews at the Omega Sanction Center; Institutional Release Officers (IROs) are situated in ADC/ACC institutions and work with parole services on releasing offenders to approved residence plans.
- (3) The overall numbers for the Special Response Team include only parole absconders and no probation absconders.
