The Office of Personnel Management (OPM) submits a request from the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management (ADEM) for your review.

ADEM requests three (3) positions from the OPM growth pool established by Arkansas Code Annotated § 21-5-225(b). The classifications requested are listed below:

#### **JUSTIFICATION**

ADEM is requesting the above positions because of two federally declared disasters recently affecting the State in 2023. One (1) Grants Coordinator position will operate as a Mitigation Grants Coordinator assisting with migration efforts and assisting the grants analyst during the recovery process. They will be working closely in community efforts to identify risk reduction efforts while working closely with the federal grants analyst and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

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This position will additionally be responsible for reviewing applications and processing reimbursements for the grant sub-recipients, submitting quarterly reports, and performing grant reconciliation and closeout management.

The salary and benefits will be 100% federally funded through the State Management Costs (SMC) received under the Public Assistance Grant Program for Disaster 4698 and subsequent federal disasters.

The other Grants Coordinator position will operate as a Public Assistance Grant Coordinator and the requested ADEM Program Coordinator will operate as Public Assistance Officer. Both positions will work with the current staffing of the Public Assistance Branch managing over \$20 million in estimated public assistance costs across numerous disasters.

The salary and benefits will be 100% federally funded through the State Management Costs (SMC) received under the Public Assistance Grant Program for Disaster 4698 and subsequent federal disasters.

## RECOMMENDATION



The first of three positions ADEM is requesting is a Grants Coordinator who will operate as a Mitigation Grants Coordinator assisting with mitigation efforts and assisting the grants analyst during the recovery process. The second Grants Coordinator position will operate as a Public Assistance Grant Coordinator, while the third position, ADEM Program Coordinator, will operate as Public Assistance Officer. All three positions will work with the current staffing of the Public Assistance Branch managing over \$20 million in estimated public assistance and mitigation costs across numerous disasters.

In addition to the duties above, these positions will be working closely in community efforts to identify risk reduction measures for mitigation as well as working toward recovery efforts for these communities all while working closely with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). These positions will also be responsible for reviewing documentation and processing reimbursements for the grant sub-recipients, submitting quarterly reports, and performing grant reconciliation and closeout management. The salary and benefits will be 100% federally funded through the State Management Costs (SMC) received under the Mitigation and Public Assistance Grant Programs for State disaster declaration DR-4698-AR and subsequent federal disasters.
