Southeast Arkansas College (SEAC) requests the establishment of six (6) positions from the Higher Education Central Pool authorized by Act 778 of 2023, ACA §6-63-319. In accordance with the provisions of the act, we are forwarding our recommendation to you for consideration.

These positions are requested due to revamping the Early Child Center into a Childcare Center and the opening of a new student housing facility. These titles are currently used at other institutions.

The Child Care Director will be responsible for the day-to-day operation of the SEAC Childcare Center. He/She will manage all financial and administrative responsibilities of the Center. In addition, the Child Care Director will maintain high quality childcare standards based on developmentally appropriate practices.

The Project/Program Administrator pool position will manage the daily operations of the 168-bed facility. He/She will determine repairs and improvements necessary for the maintenance and operation of the student housing facility. In addition, the Project/Program Administrator pool position will review, update, and enforce all housing policies to ensure the safety of the residents.

The Day Care Teachers will be responsible for the routine care & supervision of toddlers and preschoolers ranging from ages 18 Months to 5 years of age at the SEAC Childcare Center. They will maintain a safe environment by monitoring children for health, behavioral, and emotional issues and reporting concerns to staff and parents. In addition, the Day Care Teachers will provide oversight and laboratory experiences for students enrolled in an Early Childhood Degree Program at SEAC.

The Child Care Technicians will assist the Day Care Teacher with conducting routine care & supervision of toddlers and preschoolers ranging from ages 18 Months to 5 years of age at the SEAC Childcare Center. They will also assist with documenting the observation/interaction hours of college students with children at the childcare center.

The two Project/Program Managers will be SEARK's Childcare Center Lead Teachers. The managers will be responsible for the routine care and supervision of toddlers and preschoolers, as well as providing oversight and laboratory experiences for students enrolled in an Early Childhood Degree program.

The two Project/Program Specialists will be SEARK's Childcare Center Assistant Teachers. The specialists will be responsible for assisting with carrying out the routine care and supervision of toddlers and preschoolers ranging in age from 18 months to 5 years.
