### Justification:

Identifying and serving at-risk student groups to improve completion rates is part of the Huron and CCC strategic goals. Transition Studies students have been identified as the most-at-risk for attrition. The additional coaches are needed to manage the size and scope of this program going forward. As part of the new Admissions Proposal as well as current admissions practices, the number of Transition Studies admits is growing and developmental course needs expanding. We are transitioning this program to a four-year support model from a one-year model. This increases the intervention load for advisors starting this Fall. Other changes to the model that involve time and effort include a living and learning community, leadership activities, and a summer bridge program. The additional coaches will offset the increase in students served beyond the first year and expansion of duties. The Academic Success coach is the primary point of contact for a select group of students admitted through the TS program. The Success Coach will motivate, advise, assist with retention efforts from enrollment through graduation. As part of a team-approach, Success Coaches offer holistic programming to enrich program participants campus experience
