## FY2022 Cost of Living Adjustment

The executive staff and Board of Trustees of Arkansas Tech University has made the determination to award a one-time Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) payment for classified staff, as well as, to non-classified faculty and staff. The payment will be in the amount of \$1,000 on the last pay period in May and/or June 2022 where applicable.

The \$1,000 COLA payment will exceed 2% of salary for some of our classified employees.

Arkansas Tech University has performed a financial analysis and has adequate budget available for the one-time payments.
