The Arkansas State Crime Laboratory is requesting three (3) positions from the OPM central growth pool established by Ark. Code Ann. §21-5-225.

JUSTIFICATION

The Arkansas State Crime Laboratory is requesting the above Forensic Scientist positions in order to eliminate backlog issues the agency is currently encountering. The drug division of the Arkansas State Crime Laboratory has experienced a 22% increase in drug cases over the last two years. In 2017 alone, the agency received over 22,000 cases. Based on cases received so far in 2018, the agency is anticipating receiving at least 23,600 cases. Currently, the agency has a backlog of 11,000 drug cases. The current processing time for each of these cases is approximately nine months. The prolonged processing time has resulted in court date delays and issues with conducting timely trials. The agency predicts, with the addition of the requested positions, the processing time for each case will decrease to 30 days within 24 months. These positions will increase budgeted costs by \$135,030. The agency states that current funding is sufficient to cover the costs associated with these positions.
