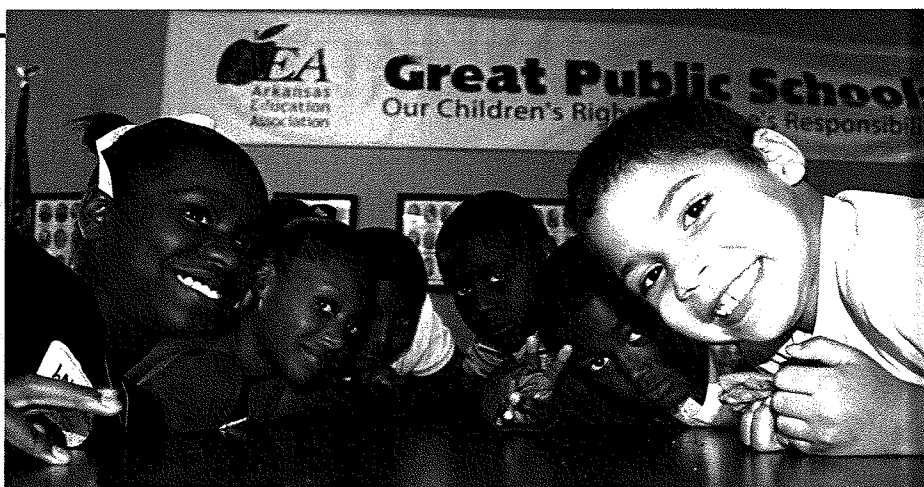

- A just society where everyone is treated fairly



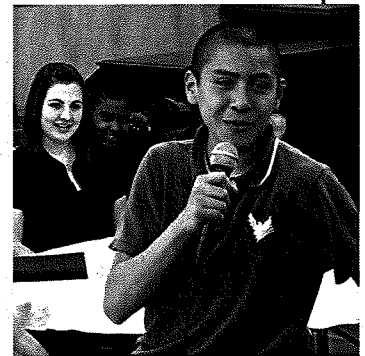
