22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 1, Subchapter 1, is amended
25	to add an additional section to read as follows:
26	17-1-111. Waiver of state occupational or professional license fee for
27	employee of state agency.
28	(a) As used in this section:
29	(1) "Occupational or professional license" means a license,
30	certificate, registration, permit, or other form of authorization:
31	(A) Issued by an occupational or professional licensing
32	entity within the executive or legislative departments of state government;
33	<u>and</u>
34	(B) Required by Arkansas law or rule for an individual to
35	ongage in a particular occupation or profession.

1	(2) "Occupational or professional licensing entity" means an
2	office, board, commission, department, council, bureau, or other agency of
3	$\underline{\text{the executive or legislative departments of state government having authority}}$
4	to license, certify, register, permit, or otherwise authorize an individual
5	to engage in a particular occupation or profession; and
6	(3) "State agency" means:
7	(A) Every board, commission, department, division, or
8	office of state government within the executive, legislative, and judicial
9	departments; and
10	(B) All state-supported postsecondary educational
11	institutions, including without limitation colleges and universities,
12	vocational and technical schools, and community colleges.
13	(b) An occupational or professional licensing entity shall waive the
14	fee assessed by the state for an occupational or professional license for an
15	individual employed by a state agency if the individual requires an
16	occupational or professional license to perform his or her job duties for the
17	state agency.
18	(c) Subsection (b) of this section does not apply to an individual
19	<pre>employed:</pre>
20	(A) By the state agency employing the individual for less than
21	one (1) year; or
22	(B) By a state agency on less than a full-time basis.
