 - Actual hands on practice and skill development

New Staff Training

- Competency based
- Reflect the knowledge and skills needed by child welfare workers
- Entry level competencies
- Combines best practice with policy, procedure and compliance outcomes
- Revised and evaluated

Continuing Education

- Higher level competencies
- DCFS identified
- Feedback evaluations
- MS develops some & brokers others
- Revised and evaluated

Training Academy – Family Service Worker

- Training Model (1 year support)
 - Training begins 1st week on the job
 - Structured orientation activities Partnership Trainer
 - CHRIS (computer system) orientation MS Trainer
 - Combination of classroom and field
 - 5 weeks of class with structured OJT on alternating weeks
 - Class MidSOUTH
 - OJT Partnership Trainer
 - On-going field training for 1st year + cont. ed

Training Academy – New Supervisor

- Training Model (1 year support)
 - Training begins 1st week on the job
 - 3 6 month orientation/OJT Partnership Trainer
 - Very structured; focused on 3 key functions of supervision as relates to supervising for Permanency, Safety and Well-Being
 - Administrative
 - Educational
 - Support
 - CHRIS as management tool (in office) MS Trainer

Training Academy – New Supervisor

- Classroom is a 3 week series (3 days/week)
- Field training for 1st year + cont. education

Training Academy – Program Assistants

- Classroom is a 3 week series (3 days/week)
- 4th week for some PAs
 - Active Parenting
 - Nurturing Parenting

Foster Parent Training

- Train prospective foster/adoptive parents referred by DCFS
- Uses nationally recognized Foster/Adopt PRIDE Training curriculum
- Provide PRIDE Orientation for DCFS staff and other programs training foster/adoptive parents

Foster Parent Training

- Recently restructured
- On-line component
- 1st 5 sessions, required checks, SAFE
 home study can accept children
- Complete weeks 6-8 within next six months

- Increase the number of abused or neglected children who can safely stay in their own homes by improving parenting skills
- Direct Service
 - 17 Educators
 - 1st year served 304 (92 parents & 212 children

- Intensive 16-session Nurturing Families Program
 - Dr. Stephen Balvolek
 - Used world-wide with families specifically at risk for child maltreatment
 - Goal: Teach parents to nurture, guide, and discipline children healthy, positive ways

- Has a DCFS staff training component
- Program Assistants as Parent Coaches


UALR Match

- Match is "in-kind"






of MidSOUTH NST and ACE Courses 07/01/2015 - 03/14/2016




% of MidSOUTH NST and ACE Courses July 1, 2015 to March 14, 2016












% of Course Hours Offered 07/01/2015 - 03/14/2016
















Participant Training Hours 07/01/2015 - 03/14/2016










