The Need

- 60+ Cleburne county children enter foster care annually (3,500 statewide)
- Over 500 Arkansas children are waiting for a forever family
- Neglected and abused children need a safe & loving environment while in foster care

How The C.A.L.L. is meeting the need in Cleburne County

- 4 Cleburne County foster homes to 17 in less than 3 years through The C.A.L.L. (4 more are currently in process)
- 5 Children adopted in less than 3 years through The C.A.L.L.
- A county wide multi-church community is growing together on the same journey of living out their faith to care for our children

The mission of The C.A.L.L is to Educate, Equip and Encourage the Body of Christ to provide a future and hope for children in foster care.

Actions The C.A.L.L. of Cleburne County takes to fulfill this mission:

- Presentations to churches, clubs and community organizations in Cleburne County
- Training local volunteers & families to fulfill their roles and share the need with others
- C.A.L.L. Informational meetings hosted at different churches monthly, monthly foster family support group meetings and events, monthly leadership meeting & bi-annual advisory board meeting
- Currently working to raise up mentoring families
