ACT 911 Monitoring

- Currently there are 496 ACT 911 clients in the state.
- Today 55 of them are inpatient at ASH and the remaining are with Community Based Providers.
- There are 8 ACT 911 Monitors that travel the state providing monitoring oversight for the ACT 911 clients.
- Each Monitor provides a weekly written report to the Medical Director of ASH that provides an overview of the status of each client on the Monitor's caseload.
- These weekly reports are reviewed by the ASH Medical Director and the ACT 911 Monitor supervisor.
- In the event an ACT 911 client experiences complications with his or her treatment and/or placement, the ASH Medical Director provides clinical direction for the client's treatment team.
