



HERS Index

- Zero to 100 point Scale.
- 100 Points was 2006 IRC Now 2009 IECC.
- 2009 IECC follows Energy Star v.2

2009 code follows Energy Star v.2

EPA says:

- 1,066 ENERGY STAR certified homes in Arkansas to date
- **67** ENERGY STAR certified homes built 2012 to date
- 252 ENERGY STAR certified homes built in 2011

Barriers to Implementation

- Cost (prescriptive)
 - \$1086 Zone 3
 - \$1690 Zone 4
 - Positive cash flow in year 2
- Enforcement
- Education

2009 IECC: Two compliance paths

- Performance: An Energy Rating report by a certified HERS Energy Rater.
 - Equals or exceeds the prescriptive code reference home based on the overall U/A or annual \$/cost .
- Prescriptive code plus duct and envelope leakage requirements
 - A) duct leakage testing (8 CFM/100ft² to outdoors)
 - B) a completed envelope air barrier/insulation checklist or blower door test (7ACH50).

Energy Ratings and Builders

- Start with plans
- Performance testing
- Interim inspections
- Estimates annual energy costs
- HERS Index (MPG for houses)
- Code compliance and enforcement
- Utility incentives
- Education






