SUBJECT: COLLECTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF GENERAL AND SPECIAL REVENUES - 2004-2005

Attached is the 2004-2005 Annual Revenue Report, which includes various schedules reflecting the collection and distribution of General and Special Revenues for the 2004-2005 fiscal year. In summary, Gross General Revenue collections of approximately \$4,756.7 million increased \$391.3 million or 8.96% over the \$4,365.4 million collected in fiscal year 2003-04. Adjusted Net General Revenues available for distribution of \$3,937.1 million increased \$338.3 million or 9.4% over the \$3,598.8 million available for distribution in fiscal year 2003-04. Gross Special Revenues of \$1,560.9 million increased \$329.9 million, or 26.8% more than the \$1,231 million collected in fiscal year 2003-04.
