Attached is the 2006-2007 Annual Revenue Report, which includes various schedules reflecting the collection and distribution of General and Special Revenues for the 2006-2007 fiscal year. In summary, Gross General Revenue collections of approximately \$5,474.4 million increased \$294.3 million or 5.68% over the \$5,180.1 million collected in fiscal year 2005-06. Adjusted Net General Revenues available for distribution of \$4,467.9 million increased \$240.1 million or 5.7% over the \$4,227.8 million available for distribution in fiscal year 2005-06. Gross Special Revenues of \$1,699.4 million increased \$42.7 million, or 2.6% more than the \$1,656.7 million collected in fiscal year 2005-06.
