Attached is the 2011-2012 Annual Revenue Report, which includes various schedules reflecting the collection and distribution of General and Special Revenues for the 2011-2012 fiscal year. In summary, Gross General Revenue collections of approximately \$5,936 million increased \$250 million or 4.4% above the \$5,686 million collected in fiscal year 2010-11. Adjusted Net General Revenues available for distribution of \$4,751.6 millionincreased \$178.8 million or 3.9% above the \$4,572.8 million available for distribution in fiscal year 2010-11. Gross Special Revenues of \$1,764.8 million increased \$30.7
