For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO ALLOW EXCESS COMMISSIONS IN THE COUNTY COLLECTOR'S COMMISSION ACCOUNT TO BE CARRIED FORWARD DURING THE FIRST QUARTER OF EACH YEAR TO PROVIDE OPERATING REVENUES FOR THE COLLECTOR'S OFFICE AND THE ASSESSOR'S OFFICE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Arkansas Code 14-21-103, Arkansas Code 14-21-106, Arkansas Code 14-15-204 or any other law, excess commissions in the collector's commission account at the end of the year may be carried forward into the following year to provide operating revenues for the collector's office and the assessor's office for the first quarter. Provided however, the amount of excess commissions carried forward shall be limited to the amount determined by the county court to be reasonably necessary to operate the assessor's office and the collector's office for the first quarter. Within thirty days after the end of the first quarter any remaining excess commissions and all interest earned on the excess commissions carried forward shall be distributed to the taxing units as provided by law.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
