HOUSE RESOLUTION

TO AMEND PARAGRAPHS (b) AND (c) OF RULE 93 OF THE RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO CLARIFY THE SAME WITH RESPECT TO PAIR VOTING.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SECOND EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

Paragraphs (b) and (c) respectively of Rule 93 of the Rules of the House of Representatives of the Seventy-Seventh General Assembly are hereby amended to read as follow:

"(b) Pairs are counted when signed by both representatives, in the presence of each other, and witnessed by another representative and with one of the pairing members present and at his seat when the vote is taken and counted.

(c) Pairs shall be presented to the Speaker of the House and accepted by the Speaker only on the date the vote is to be taken for which the representatives are paired. Members may pair only once a day on a particular proposition."□
